
Versatile and widespread printing access

Employees can print documents from any email-capable device;⁴ from the HP ePrint Enterprise app for AndroidTM, Apple[®], or BlackBerry[®]; and from the HP ePrint Mobile Driver for laptops and tablets. Nearly every file type is supported. Plus, HP ePrint Enterprise is a driverless solution, so employees can print to all networked printers—including both HP and non-HP models.

Print with ease

It's easy for employees to find a compatible printer. They can search for the nearest networked printer using the app's context-based printer directory, or they can tap into their mobile device's GPS search functions to find close-by HP ePrint Public Print Locations. You can also give guests temporary access to networked printers while still maintaining security safeguards.

1. Select the content you want to print.
From your mobile device, choose what you want to print.

2. Select a printer.
Search for and choose a printer, using keywords or your mobile device's "Near Me" GPS capabilities to find the most convenient printer. Use either the HP ePrint Enterprise app or email-to-print capabilities.

3. Hit print.
Select the printer and hit print. Documents are processed within your company's private cloud using HP ePrint Enterprise software, and will then be sent to the designated printer or print server queue.

4. Get confirmation and retrieve your documents.
You'll receive a confirmation notice of your print job. Pick up your document at the device.

Command printing policies and security

HP ePrint Enterprise allows your organization to control which printers are available to HP ePrint users by defining printer security policies for users and groups. Other security and print management features include:

- Enterprise-level security safeguards—Manage robust security systems and integrate with your company's pull- and PIN-printing solutions.
- Database synchronization—Leverage your existing user database by automatically syncing with existing LDAP organizational databases or manually synchronizing using a CSV file.

- Ready-to-print rendering support—Save time by designating file formats that will be sent and rendered directly at the printer port rather than the server.
- Advanced licensing functions—Expand licenses, share them among multiple deployments, and track their use.
